Entries are now sought for the above competition to be played on Saturday 12th September at Mylor (and possibly Sunday 13th September).

The club are looking to put in Four mixed Triples to complement Four entries received from Penryn, Mawnan Smith and one other.

The competition, if eight entries are received will be played thus:

Two groups of 4 Triples will be drawn. Each Triple to play the other three in their group over ten ends with 2 points for a win, 1 for a draw.

At the end of the round Robin, the First Triple in each group to play off over 10 ends to decide the winners and runners-up. The runners-up in each group to play off for third and fourth places.

In the event of a tie on points the highest shot total to win.

In the event of over-subscription, they will choose the Triples to play.

Players will be asked to arrive by 0930 for the draw to take place and play to begin.
